<b>COURSE</b>	NURS-3510 (course also open to non-nursing students) The Human Meaning of Death
<b>TERM</b>	Summer (Late June – August)
<b>LECTURE TIMES</b>	Mondays and Wednesdays, 11:30 a.m.-2:20 p.m.
<b>OUTLINE</b>	An examination of the human experience of death and dying, the meaning of human life, ethical and cultural aspects of euthanasia and advanced directives. Lectures, readings, films, and discussions will explore a variety of significant thinkers and concepts concerning death, encouraging students to examine their own feelings and attitudes towards death.

**Qualifications:** Successful applicants will have appropriate academic credentials and teaching competence, as set forth in Article 54:06 (a) of the Collective Agreement, and a graduate degree.

**Must be available to teach for the entire term, with no conflicting personal or work commitments.**
