TERM	Summer (Late June - August)
OUTLINE	A study of the basic principles of nutrition and their relationship to health promotion, disease prevention, health maintenance, and restorative care. The focus will be on the nutritional requirements of healthy individuals and individuals with health disruptions across the life span.
QUALIFICATIONS	Successful applicants must have appropriate academic credentials and teaching competence, as set forth in Article 54:06(a) of the Collective Agreement. Also must be a Registered Dietitian with current registration with the College of Dietitians and possess a Master's degree or higher with a nutrition major or related field. Must be available to teach for the entire term, with no conflicting personal or work commitments
