<p><b>FRSC 3105</b> <b>(14-57-302-01)</b>  Forensic Identification</p>	<p>Practical application of principles and protocols used in forensic identification. Topics range from the expectations of the public in forensic practices to the legal responsibilities of crime scene specialists for evidence identification. Fingerprint theory and practice, image capture and enhancement, crime scene protocols and management, biometrics, and identification as contrasted to systematics are studied. (Prerequisite: FRSC-2007 and enrollment in this course is limited to Majors in Forensic Science and BA Combined in Forensics.)</p> <p>Two week duration: dates TBD in consultation with the successful applicant</p>
<p><b>Qualifications:</b></p>	<p>The successful candidate should hold a Master's degree by the date of appointment, a Ph.D. degree is preferred. Professional experience will be considered for equivalency to academic training.</p>

*\*The course above is subject to budgetary approval and sufficient enrollment.*

*Applications must include:*

- A letter of interest in the position
- Two letters of reference
- A resume outlining relevant work experience, training, teaching experience, honours or awards, publications and relevant service activities
- A teaching portfolio demonstrating evidence of teaching excellence. For example: SET scores or other teaching evaluations, course outlines, graduate courses taken, dissertation or thesis topics, evidence of successful teaching, or/and evidence of professional experience.

Applicants from outside the University of Windsor should provide three letters of reference.
