COURSE	NURS-8610 Therapeutics in Primary Health Care I
TERM	September - December 2 sections: Fridays 8:30-11:30 am or 1:00-4:00 pm
OUTLINE	This course introduces concepts integral to pharmacotherapy, advanced counselling, and complementary therapies predominantly related to common episodic conditions of clients across the lifespan. It emphasizes the therapeutic care plan approach which focuses on the following aspects: drug-related problems, goals of therapies, analysis of different therapeutic approaches, need for referral, monitoring parameters, acceptability to the client, and follow-up.
QUALIFICATIONS	Successful applicants will have academic credentials and teaching competence, as set forth in Article 54:06(a) of the Collective Agreement, a graduate degree in Nursing and be registered with the College of Nurses of Ontario as an RN(EC). Must be available to teach for the entire term, with no conflicting personal or work commitments.
